- everything is fine with this course. The coursework is unusual. I get the idea behind it but i feel like it didn't really test the understandings of the material .
- Great module. Really enjoyed it.
- The course was nice! Interesting and a good base for anyone that didn't know anything about finance before. Feedback on the coursework wasn't very helpful.
- This module was one of my favourites this year and I found it to be an excellent introduction to finance for someone who had no previous knowledge. However, I think I could have benefitted a lot from doing more exercises. Although the coursework was a very fun activity, it only covered a small part of the taught content. I felt like the course lacked ways to apply the theory learned in class, specifically numerical questions to get used to the equations and understand better when and how to apply them. Although the suggested textbook did have some good exercises, it did not have a free answer key (some outdated versions online only) and so checking answers and verifying my understanding was very difficult. Overall an excellent course, but could be improved with more exercises or assignments.
- The contents are well-structured to cover the fundamentals of finance. However, CW is too daunting as there are too many rounds. Perhaps it can be helpful to reduce the number of rounds in the early stages, where each card has much less impact.

Past papers should have been made available to allow for practice.

- More practice questions / a past paper or two would be great to help prepare for the exam
- The lecture content as well as Professor Savitar's teaching style really makes the module very interesting. The coursework is unique and helps in the understanding of key concepts.
